Thanks a lot! will try to find a chance to test USB3.0 and the DSDT.aml,

I thought there was something wrong with my clover. I have upgraded to the latest Clover_v2.4k_r4200, then I changed the PBR to nothing beside the Default boot volume in config.plist, unselected fast and set a 3 seconds timeout. in this way the system will boot directly to OS X which does not need to hit enter on Clover boot manager.

And miraculously, the system will become stable after some glitch on the external monitor during the power-on while the lid closed. then everything works great... now I have my external 34UC88 monitor at displayport(only can do 50hz) via Dell docking station, and bluetooth keyboard and mouse works great..so every time I just need to press the power on button on the Docking station to get things started.

Very satisfied with the current setup now, works like a chime.

my setup is e6330 i7/16G ram/256 Samsung ssd/1T hd at CD-ROM bay.
