In regards to your Defaults.plist the extraction via MMTool oder UEFITool sometimes breaks the XML-format which leads to the mentioned issue with PListEdit Pro.

Just use another Editor like [TextMate](#), which has Syntax Highlighting to help you find the corrupt lines which prevent PlistEdit Pro to load the file correctly.
