Actually that's no big surprise since venturas AMD graphic drivers rely on AVX2 which IVY Bridge isn't capeable of. Even though you are able to run Ventura on IvyBridge by replacing it's os.dmg with the one pulled from an Apple Silicone Mac or it's restore image the graphic drivers will not load as long as AVX2 support is missing. For now Ventura on IvyBridge is retricted to older graphics such as HD4000 or any AMD or Nvidia graphics supported by the legacy Patcher...
