UPDATE: workaround
It is suspected that Apple APFS driver is either buggy or not compatible with FV2 software decryption, since all officially
supported models are T2 equipped. FV2 in some cases gets automatically enabled during Tahoe upgrade.
Partition embedded APFS driver is also updated during the process, so it may affect all encrypted volumes in the same
container.
To restore your ability to boot use macOS Recovery to disable FV2 encryption on selected volume.
To use FV2, temporary workaround is to add apple\_aligned.efi to your OC Drivers and disable APFS Jumpstart to disallow
loading the partition embedded driver (thanks @y010656 @mhaeuser )
