If you already have a working Defaults.plist, just do the NVRAM Reset and your AppStore, iCloud, iMessage should work again.

In regards to HDMI-Audio, your DSDT has to be patched to enable that.

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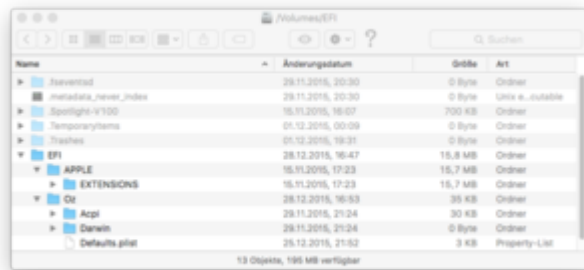
