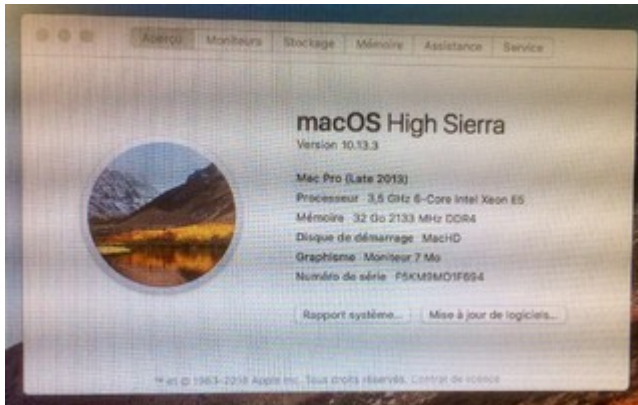

In that case boot to clover, go to the EFI-Shell and use the necessary section from the following Link to rename (mv) three files in the folder /EFI/CLOVER/drivers64UEFI:

The files are:

AptioMemoryFix.efi -> rename to "AptioMemoryFix.efi.bak"

OsxAptioFix2Drv-64.efi.bak -> rename to "OsxAptioFix2Drv-64.efi"

EmuVariableUefi-64.efi.bak -> rename to "EmuVariableUefi-64.efi"

Then reboot again..

Too bad...

in that case boot from your clover bootstick to use the EFI-Shell from there to rename the whole folder EFI to EFI-bad and EFI-old (or whatever you used) to EFI.

Then reboot without the clover bootstick.
